PARENTAL CONSENT AND COMPETITION ENTRY FORM

In this form, a parent/legal guardian is required to give consent to their child to participate in the "EcoSmart Kids" competition, following the participation in the EcoSmart Kids workshop. All participating children in the workshops will be supervised at all times by their teachers and our team who all carry valid "Working With Children" permits from the Victoria State Government.

Entries need to be either clearly photographed, scanned or as recorded videos in high quality for our judges to review. They must be submitted digitally to us, with the file clearly labelled with the child's full name and grade. Entries that do not have this information, cannot be accepted.

Please also send in a clear scan or photograph of this fully completed and signed form, with your competition entry. Entry forms that are hard to read or not fully completed will not be accepted.

Competition entry forms and entries must be received by the end of Monday 10th August 2026.
